
in the below listed situations wherein the Clerk or the Administrative Judge or designee may reassign cases as may be necessary to carry out the further provisions of this order as follows:

County Court cases wherein an attorney of record works in the law firms of Carr & Carr are to be assigned to all County Court Judges other than the Honorable Mike Carr by a method approved by the Administrative Judge, approximating an equal split.

County Court cases wherein an attorney of record works in the law firm of Berry, Day & McFee shall be assigned to all County Court Judges other than the Honorable Janeice T. Martin by a method approved by the Administrative Judge, approximating an equal split.

County Court cases wherein an attorney of record works for the law firm of Becker & Poliakoff are to be assigned to all County Court Judges other than the Honorable Michael J. Provost by a method approved by the Administrative Judge, approximating an equal split.
