ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO: 2.11

Pursuant to § 932.704, Fla. Stat. (1995), all civil forfeiture cases filed pursuant to Florida Statutes §§ 893.12, 932.703 and 932.704 for the forfeiture of real or personal property, including vessels, motor vehicles or aircraft, shall be assigned to and heard by a circuit court judge of the civil division. All such assignments shall be made by the Clerk of Court on a random selection basis.

This order supersedes and replaces prior Administrative Order 2.11 (February 5, 1992).
