**BODILY ATTACHMENT WRIT & ARREST WARRANT - RULE 12.615(e)**

TO ALL AND SINGULAR THE SHERIFFS OF FLORIDA:

You are hereby directed to take into custody:

and to bring this respondent before the judge at the First Appearance 24 hour hearing in the county where he or she is arrested as soon as possible after arrest and in no event more than **WITHIN 48 HOURS** after arrest, for a hearing under Rule 12.615(e) before the First Appearance judge to determine the respondent's present, immediate ability to pay the amount set below, which is owed for child support, at the time he or she appears before the First Appearance judge. You may hold the respondent in custody FOR ONLY 48 HOURS during which time the respondent must be brought before the First Appearance judge. The respondent must be released in this case after 48 hours if not brought before the First Appearance judge in the county where arrested within that time. Service and execution of this writ may be made on any day of the week and at any time of the day or night. If the respondent is taken to a First Appearance hearing and he is not released in this case after that hearing and if he is still in custody on this writ after any First Appearance hearing, you must return the respondent to the next First Appearance hearing within 24 hours for a continued hearing on his present, immediate ability to pay the amount set below, and likewise every 24 hours that he is in custody under this writ. **DO NOT hold this respondent for a hearing before the undersigned judge.** If the First Appearance judge determines at any time that the respondent does not have the present, immediate ability to pay the sum below, then the First Appearance judge shall order the respondent released in this case immediately.

**However, this writ may be cancelled and the above-named person immediately released from custody if the total sums of \$\_\_\_\_\_ in unpaid support, which is the total purge payment. The court previously found in this proceeding that the respondent had the ability to pay said sums.**

Upon receipt of the purge payment, the sheriff's office receiving payment must provide the respondent with a written receipt acknowledging payment, which must be carried on the person of the respondent for a period of at least 30 days from the date of payment as proof of such payment. A sheriff receiving such payment shall forward the funds to the sheriff who entered the information about the writ into the Florida Crime Information Center system and who shall forward the funds to the State of Florida Disbursement Unit, PO Box 8500, Tallahassee, FL 32314-8500, with a reference on the payment to "Lee County, Florida," and this case number.
