ORDER GRANTING FATHER'S MOTION FOR PASSPORT AND TRAVEL

This matter having come before the court on December 21, 2009 on the father's motion for authority to apply for a U.S. passport and to allow foreign travel for M.C. R., born (*Date omitted*), it is ordered:

Father's motion is granted - The father, A. R., who is the father of M. C. R., born (*Date omitted*). The child lives with the father most of the days of the year. The court now orders that the father and this child may travel or the father may send this child to any foreign country outside of the United States and any of its territories at any time until this child reaches majority, that is, the age of 18 years. At any time the father may also take or send this child on a cruise ship with ports of call that are not in the United States or any of its territories. He may alone sign Form DS-3053 or any other form required by the U.S. State Department or any other agency or office of the United States or any state of the United States or any foreign government necessary to obtain a passport, visa or other travel document or proof of citizenship. The signature or consent of the child's mother is not required for the father to obtain a passport, visa or other travel document or proof of citizenship and to travel with this child or to send this child to any place outside of the United States and any of its territories as long as this child is a minor.
