**1. Minutes and ISC Actions on 10/25/04.**

Action: Motion to Approve Minutes as submitted passed unanimously.

**3. Review of additional applications for ISC Registry**

ACTION: ISC APPROVED 10 NEW APPLICATIONS FOR THE REGISTRY. DAVID A. BRENNER WAS APPROVED FOR CAPITAL CASES CONSISTENT WITH RULE IN EXCEPTIONAL CASES. ONE APPLICATION TO BE REMOVED WAS ACCEPTED.

**4. Criminal Court Appointed Counsel- Request for Revision to ISC Registry Appointment Categories and Qualifications**

Action: Motion to reject the proposal to consolidate categories and to maintain the current ISC qualifications were approved.

**5. Policy for Adding Attorneys to the ISC Registry**

Action: ISC Committee approved an open process for application with approval and update of the registry on a quarterly basis. Attorneys requesting removal will be deleted from the registry immediately by the Staff attorney pending formal action by the ISC.

**6. Requests for Amendment of Fee Schedule**

- Marchman/Baker Act – amended to \$100./per hour NTE \$400. per case
- Dependency- \$1000 per case, to include shelter hearings, payable at adjudication/disposition of the case (Attorneys to suggest additional definition of this trigger point); \$250 additional fee for work subsequent to disposition but prior to TPR petition; \$1000. flat fee for TPR.
