*All new United Family Court cases filed after the date of this Order shall be assigned evenly and randomly to the judges serving in the aforementioned divisions (see page 1) and are subject to reassignment under Rule 12.003 Fla. Fam. L.R.P.

The assignments are to be made by an approved random selection method unless otherwise indicated, and certified to the Court Administrator on behalf of the Chief Judge. **NO** case shall be specifically assigned or reassigned without a **written** Order issued by the Chief Judge or Administrative Judge, except in the below listed situations wherein the Clerk or the Administrative Judge may reassign the cases as necessary to carry out the further provisions of this order as follows:

All present and future cases assigned to the Honorable Amanda Levy-Reis wherein the attorney of record is Ruth D. Orange shall be assigned to another judge in the same division. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the divisions.

All present and future cases assigned to the Honorable Elizabeth V. Krier wherein the attorney of record is Kenneth D. Krier shall be assigned to another judge in the same division. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the divisions.

All present and future cases assigned to the Honorable Elizabeth V. Krier wherein the attorney of record works in law firm of Rios, Suarez and Weinberg shall be assigned to another judge in the same division. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the divisions.

All present and future cases assigned to the Honorable Joseph G. Foster wherein the attorney of record is Porter Wright shall be assigned to another judge in the same division. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the divisions.

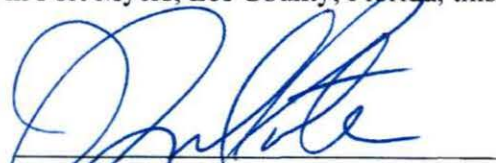

When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the divisions.
