ORDER

*All new United Family Court cases filed after the date of this Order shall be assigned evenly and randomly to the judges serving in the aforementioned divisions (see page 1) and are subject to reassignment under Rule 12.003 Fla. Fam. L.R.P.

The assignments are to be made by an approved random selection method unless otherwise indicated, and certified to the Court Administrator on behalf of the Chief Judge. **NO** case shall be specifically assigned or reassigned without a **written** Order issued by the Chief Judge or Administrative Judge, except in the below listed situations wherein the Clerk or the Administrative Judge may reassign the cases as necessary to carry out the further provisions of this order as follows:

All cases presently assigned to the Honorable James R. Shenko wherein the attorney of record is Michael F. Kayusa shall be reassigned to the Honorable Hugh D. Hayes or the Honorable Lauren L. Brodie until further notice of this Court. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the Clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the Circuit Civil, Probate and Guardianship divisions.

All cases presently assigned to the Honorable Hugh D. Hayes wherein the attorney of record works in the law firm of Grant Fridkin Pearson, P.A. shall be reassigned to the Honorable Lauren L. Brodie or the Honorable James R. Shenko until further notice of this Court. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with the Order, the Clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the Circuit Civil, Probate and Guardianship divisions.

All present and future cases assigned to the Honorable Elizabeth V. Krier wherein the attorney of record works in the law firm of Cummings & Lockwood shall be assigned to another judge in the same division. When the Clerk reassigns a case in accordance with this Order, the clerk shall, so far as is reasonably practical, assign new cases in order to obtain an equal assignment of cases in the division.

In the event of reassignments, they should comply with the aforementioned conditions.

THE CLERK is hereby directed to change the assignment to comply with the above.
