YOU MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING:

(As stated in Administrative Rule 15A-10.018)

- PICTURED ID
- PROOF OF RESIDENCY
- TICKET
- BLOOD ALCOHOL CONTENT READINGS/STATEMENT OF REFUSAL
- CURRENT LIFETIME COPY OF DRIVING RECORD (Pulled within 30 days of enrollment)
(If you held a license for less than 3 years in Florida, you need to also obtain a driving record from the prior state you held a license.) If you have an out of state, license you need to obtain a driving record from that state.
- ARREST AFFIDAVIT/REPORT (COMPLETE)
- ALL COURT PAPERWORK (including case number and name of judge)

If you do not have the above items, you are required to obtain these documents from the county clerk's office that you received our DUI. You cannot enroll without the proper paperwork.

- IT WILL TAKE 45 MINUTES TO AN HOUR FOR ENROLLMENT

The following are the documents the department uses to determine residence. Your program can use any one of the items.

- Deed , mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or residential rental/lease agreement
- Florida voter registration card
- Florida vehicle registration or title. Print a duplicate registration at www.gorenew.com
- Florida boat registration or title
- Two proofs of residential address from applicant's parent, step-parent, legal guardian, or other person with whom the applicant resides, along with (see next)
- A statement from a parent , step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the applicant resides, combined with two proofs of their residential address (see above)
- A utility hook up or work order dated within 60 days of the application
- Automobile payment booklet
- Selective service card
- Medical or health card with address listed
- Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill
- Current automobile insurance policy or bill
- Transients-Sexual offender/Predator/Career offender: FDLE Registration form completed by local sheriff's department
- Educational institution transcript forms for the current school year
- Unexpired professional license issued by a government agency in the U.S.
- W-2 form or 1099 form
- Form DS2019, Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) status
- A letter from a homeless shelter, transitional service provider, or a half-way house verifying that they receive mail for the customer. The letter must be accompanied by the Certification of Address Form (see next)
- Certification of Address Form combined with a letter from a homeless shelter, transitional service provider, or a half-way house (see above)
- Utility bills, not more than two months old
- Mail from financial institutions; including checking, savings or investment account statements, not more than two months old
- Mail from Federal, State County or City government agencies

Proof of work:

A current pay stub, recent W-2, or letter from employer

Proof of school attendance:
