NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.050(b) and the inherent authority of the Court to assign cases throughout the circuit, it is


**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Civil Traffic Infraction Hearing Officer Program of Collier County shall be administered by the Administrative Circuit Judge.

2. In any instance where traffic hearing officers do not have jurisdiction to preside over an infraction as set forth in Rule 6.630(d)(1)-(3), or in any other instance expressly exempted by Florida law, the case shall be assigned to the Civil Division County Court Judge for disposition.

This order shall take effect upon its execution and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
