ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE coming before the Court based upon an inquiry from the Honorable Scott W. Weinstein, Esquire, President of the Lee County Bar Association, and in consultation with the presidents of the Collier, Lee and Charlotte County Bar Associations, as to the advisability of implementing a "Summer Dress Code" for the members of the respective bar associations within the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, the Court finds and it is hereby,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That from Memorial Day through Labor Day (May 26, 2003 through September 1, 2003), the Court finds that it is acceptable and appropriate for all lawyers within the Twentieth Judicial Circuit to wear a coat with no tie or a tie with no coat to those proceedings in which members of the general public do not typically appear, such as motion calendars, docket soundings, and pre trial conferences.

2. That lawyers following the aforesated procedures shall not be deemed in violation of the provisions of Administrative Order 2.13 (17), Re: Standards of Courtroom Decorum.

3. That pursuant to the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar and local Administrative Order 2.20 (Standards of Professional Courtesy and Conduct) lawyers must continue to be guided by the requirements of proper decorum and dignity appropriate for all courtroom proceedings.

4. That notwithstanding anything to the contrary found within this order,


