- 2. That lawyers following the aforestated procedures shall not be deer violation of the provisions of Administrative Order 2.13 (17), Re: Standards of Courtroom Decorum.
- 3. That pursuant to the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar and local Administrative Order 2.20 (Standards of Professional Courtesy and Conduct) lawyers must continue to be guided by the requirements of proper decorum and dignity appropriate for all courtroom proceedings.
