**WHEREAS**, since the original entry of the Order Establishing County Court Division for the City of Cape Coral in 2002, the use of technology and the ability to conduct court business remotely has advanced to a point where pleadings are now primarily filed electronically, and the types of proceedings to be conducted in the City of Cape Coral are now primarily conducted remotely without the need for parties to appear in person; and

**WHEREAS**, resources available to the Court, the Clerk, and other governmental agencies involved are increasingly limited based upon both budgetary constraints and ongoing staffing and employee retention issues;

It is **ORDERED** that local Administrative Order 2.32 is no longer necessary or feasible and is, hereby, **VACATED**.
