WHEREAS, this Court has determined that the Public Defender's Office is routinely appointed at first appearance to represent most criminal Defendants; and,

WHEREAS, Defendants in criminal matters on many occasions retain private counsel at or near the time the Public Defender is appointed; and,


WHEREAS, this sometimes results in private counsel being erroneously appointed by the Court to represent allegedly indigent Defendants; it is, therefore,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that all private counsel who are retained to represent criminal Defendants at or after the time of first appearance shall promptly provide the Public Defender with a copy of the initial appearance/notice of appearance as counsel in the case. The certificate of service on this notice should show service to the Honorable Douglas M. Midgley, Public Defender, Post Office Drawer 1980, Fort Myers, Florida, 33902-1980.
