
IN RE: ASSIGNMENT OF CRIMINAL

In the event co-defendants are assigned to different Judges at the booking stage, the Judge assigned the greatest number of defendants will be assigned all companion cases.

If two or more Judges are assigned an equal number of co-defendants, then the Judge assigned the defendant whose name would appear first alphabetically will be assigned all cases.
