WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature during the 2013 session passed House Bill No. 7017, which was entered into law effective January 1, 2014, Laws of Florida, Chapter 2013-25; and


WHEREAS, Chapter 2013-25 amended Florida Statute § 905.01(3) to provide that "The chief judge of each circuit court shall regularly order the convening of the grand jury for a term of 6 months;"

It is, therefore, by the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.215(b),

ORDERED that effective January 1, 2014, Grand Juries for the counties of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit shall be convened for 6 month terms covering the periods of January 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>. Regardless of the exact date of impanelment, the 6 month term shall terminate as set forth above, unless an extension is requested pursuant to Florida Statute § 905.095.

This Administrative Order shall be effective January 1, 2014, *nunc pro tunc*.

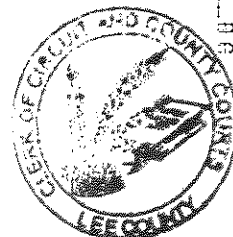
