



Ct. 6.480(b), the Clerks of Court are hereby empowered to allow, at their discretion, a reasonable amount of time before requiring the payment of civil penalties or costs in any case where a traffic violator elects to attend a driver improvement course approved by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles in accordance with §§ 318.14 (9) and 318.14 (10), Florida Statutes.
