ORDER REPEALING AND RESCINDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS 8.1 AND 8.2



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO: 8.2

The Intake Counselor for Children and Youth Services of the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services (HRS) shall forthwith notify the Office of the Public Defender of those children requesting its services and shall direct the child and his parents to immediately contact the Office of the Public Defender for an appointment to be interviewed.

The Division of Children and Youth Services of HRS shall have all predisposition reports filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court, Juvenile Division, no later than three (3) days prior to the disposition hearing.
