ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO: 8.3

When any child dies while under the jurisdiction of the Court, the Department of Health & Rehabilitative Services or any other involved social agency shall, as soon as possible, notify the judge presiding over the case and the Chief Judge of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of the circumstances surrounding the death and any information regarding the viewing, funeral arrangements, and burial as well as follow-up reports and any other relative information.




