ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 8.5

Pursuant to § 985.304, Fla. Stat. (1997), and Rule 1.810, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, the Chief Judge shall maintain a list of qualified persons who have agreed to serve as community arbitrators for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the Florida Juvenile Justice Continuum.


Toward that end, individuals will be selected as community arbitrators by the Chief Judge, the Senior Circuit Court Judge assigned to juvenile cases in the circuit, and the State Attorney. The community arbitrators shall be trained or experienced in juvenile causes and shall be:

- (a) either a graduate of an accredited law school or of an accredited school with a degree in behavioral social work or trained in conflict resolution techniques; and,
- (b) a person of the temperament necessary to deal properly with cases involving children and with the family crises likely to be presented to the arbitrator.

The list of community arbitrators shall be updated from time to time as may be appropriate under the circumstances, and will be available in the Administrative Office of the Courts.
