ORDER AUTHORIZING WAIVER  
OF CONFIDENTIALITY FOR  
DOMESTIC VIOLENCE/FAMILY LAW INVESTIGATORS  
AND OTHER COURT PERSONNEL

In accordance with Local Rule IX of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, the Administrative Judge of the Family Law Division is empowered to enter such orders as may be necessary to authorize the Domestic Violence/Family Law Investigator or such other personnel employed by the Court to be persons for whom confidentiality under Florida Statutes §§ 39.045 and 39.443 is waived. Such orders shall be executed by the Administrative Judge and kept on file with the Chief Judge and the Court Administrator of the Twentieth Circuit. Any orders entered pursuant to this order are to remain in effect for only so long as the employee(s) are employed by the Court in the capacity for which the order was entered.
