SUPPORT, ALIMONY, AND VISITATION PROGRAM
OF COLLIER COUNTY CLERK OF COURTS

There is established within the Twentieth Judicial Circuit Court for Collier County a Support, Alimony, and Visitation Enforcement Program (S.A.V.E.). The Collier County S.A.V.E Program will be operated by the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court.

This Program is hereby established and will function under the aegis of this Court and within the guidelines set forth in Fla. Fam. L. R. P. 12.750. Consistent with the intent of this rule, that the Circuit Court should fulfill its responsibility to make available to the citizens within its jurisdiction an organized system for full-service support and visitation cases, the S.A.V.E. Program shall assist in non Title IV-D family law actions involving child support, alimony, and visitation matters so as to achieve a fair and efficient resolution of these issues. It shall have the power to enforce existing support judgments and orders and to resolve collateral matters reasonably related to support or visitation issues.

The Clerk of the Circuit Court as the Support, Alimony, and Visitation Administrator may charge reasonable fees and costs may be assessed against any party in an action or hearing handled by the S.A.V.E administrator.
