Pursuant to this Court's recognized role in promoting the prompt and efficient administration of justice in the courts of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, as well as the authority prescribed by Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.215 (formerly Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.050), the Court hereby establishes a protocol for assessing and collecting fees in connection with Probation services.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that for all criminal defendants who are placed on County Probation, the Clerk of Court in and for Collier County is authorized to collect a supervision fee in the amount of Sixty-five Dollars (\$65.00) per month effective June 1, 2004.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that unless declared indigent by the sentencing court pursuant to Ch. 948.09, F.S., all such persons shall pay to the Clerk of Court the necessary fee. Effective June 1, 2005, the fee will be Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) per month.

THE COURT ORDERS that for all persons placed on Home Monitoring, the Clerk of Court in and for Collier County is authorized to collect a supervision fee in the amount of Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00) for each day of supervision.

UPON RECEIPT OF PAYMENT, the Clerk of Court shall remit said fees, less an administrative fee, agreed to by the Chief Judge and Clerk of Court, to the Board of County Commissioners on a monthly basis.
