Item 1) Jail Population Update

Sgt. Travis Allen, LCSO

- Since March, 2019 there has been a decrease in jail sentenced inmates. This is attributed to Hurricane Michael.
- Other overall numbers have shown little change.

- July is Opioid Awareness Month. An event will be held July 26th at FGCU from 9:00 a.m. to Noon. Dr. Jason Hunt from the University of Florida will be the key note speaker.

Item 3) Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Inc.

Robert Tabor, Community Manager and Larry Allen, CEO

- Presentation on Services and Funding for the 20th Judicial Circuit spanning 14 counties including
 - Vision
 - Mission Statement
 - What we do
 - Services offered including services not covered under private insurance
 - Pending projects (contract provides 14 provisional projects)
 - Values
 - o Innovation
 - Accountability
 - Advocacy
 - Transparency
 - Collaboration with 14 counties and 7 managing entities as well as other health care agencies and Sheriff's Office to better serve needs
 - 13,300 served so far this year (numbers compare to last year and anticipate going up due to Opioid assistance).
 - Understanding the System of Care and Critical Needs such as housing [safe, stable and affordable],
 county health plans and access to medications needed.
 - Very proud of CAT (Community Action Treatment) Teams.

Item 4) <u>Lee County Homeless Coalition</u> Janet Bartos, Executive Director

- Lee County Continuum of Care Strategic Plan including:
 - Lee's Investment for Everyone (LIFE) Ten Year Plan to end homelessness implemented in 2009.
 - o Implement the 2019-2028 Strategic Plan to ensure that homelessness in Lee County is rare, brief and to be experienced one-time.
 - We are in the process of forming committees focusing on data for trends and looking at system performance measures.
 - o SOAR Groups assist with disability benefits while Outreach Groups provide services to the community.
 - We do work with sex offenders.
 - o Partnering with LCSO to address statistics on incompetency issues with judiciary on housing issues.
 - Programs providing bus rides to SalusCare and access to necessary medication have already been established by LCSO.
